



BEVERLY HILLS HOTEL- BEVERLY HILLS, CALIFORNIA

DESCRIPTION: Beverly Hills Hotel (360,590 square-foot) consists of 450 guest rooms, meeting rooms, restaurants, ballrooms, sports facilities, hotel support functions and parking for 3,000 cars. Typical hotel floor levels are elevated above the above grade parking to maximize views to the adjacent golf courses. Larger room functions such as meeting rooms are located outside the bearing wall structure of typical floors. Enclosed by the undulating roof forms these large scale functions terrace down from the elevated lobby to the covered car arrival at grade. The eight story tower contain the 450 rooms with view of the Santa Monica Mountains, Century City, and adjacent Beverly Hills Country Club Golf Course.
