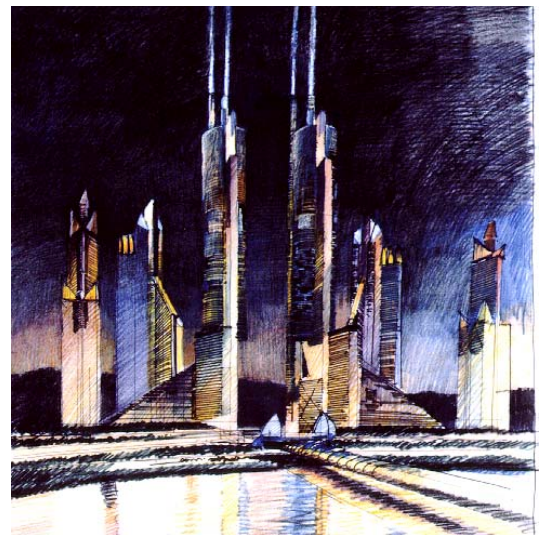


**BRISBANE 2000 - BRISBANE, CALIFORNIA**

**CLIENT:** Tuntex Land Development  
**COMPLETION:** 1990 (Design)

**DESCRIPTION:** This master plan is for the development of 50,000,000 square feet of mixed-use development on 800 acres of land between downtown San Francisco International Airport and San Francisco. The area is served by major freeways, fixed rail transit, and bus lines. The program includes office buildings, housing, hotel, shops, a retail entertainment center and a golf course. The highest density development is set back to the rear of the site to maximize the views and is located at and between two train stops on a linear spine. Pedestrian streets and shops elevated above parking structures parallel the fixed movement systems. Office buildings and apartments plug into a spine complex of transportation, fixed-rail, people mover, vehicular circulation and parking. The shopping complex features electronic displays and simulations related to merchandise display and entertainment.
