



**LOS ANGELES METRO RAIL BLUE LINE STATION- (CHINATOWN) LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA**

**CLIENT:** Metropolitan Transit Authority-Los Angeles

**COMPLETION:** 1994

**DESCRIPTION:** *This station is a high profile double loaded elevated light rail station on the line that connects Downtown Los Angeles with Pasadena and the San Gabriel Valley. The station is the first outbound stop from Downtown, and is located in the cultural and historic Chinatown district. The canopy of the station addresses the topography of the site while having an aesthetic response to the local cultural sensibility of the district.*
