



HOTEL MERIDIAN- SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE

CLIENT: The Harapan Group
COMPLETION: 1984

DESCRIPTION: Design winning competition for a 460,000 square-foot multiuse hotel and shopping complex with 465 luxury rooms adjacent to a multilevel open atrium with retail shopping, restaurants, meeting rooms, and recreational facilities. The hotel features a cantilevered stepped facade that provides a protected seven-story high space for the roadway arrival. The facade design lessens the massing on Orchard Road. Beginning at the lobby level, a spacious skylit atrium runs the full height of the hotel and is the center of all hotel activity. Due to the specific ISD (secret service) security requirement of prohibiting the placement of windows along one-third of the Orchard Road facade, the design provides every second room in that area with private landscaped light wells.

COST: \$ 30 million
ROLE: As former Corporate Director of design for DMJM, Anthony Lumsden was responsible for the design.
STATUS: Project is built.
