DESCRIPTION: *Design of a 180,000 square foot administration building which functions as the county's seat of government. The facility provides for the county's administration functions, including elections, supervisors' chambers, personnel, food service, assessor, auditor/controller, general services, county counsel, board of supervisors, clerk of the board and the county administrative officer.*

COST: \$ 18 million
