



RAHARDJA CENTRE- SINGAPORE

CLIENT: Mr. Hendra Rahardja
COMPLETION: 1984 (Design)

DESCRIPTION: This competition winning design for the Rahardja Centre located on reclaimed land adjacent to Raffles Hotel is the largest project ever (3,500,000 square-foot) awarded by the Singapore Urban Development Agency. The project consists of three hotels, a 72 story (1,480 rooms), a 63-story (936 rooms), and a 10-story hotel (430 rooms). In addition there is a convention center, retail, marina and parking. Curved in plan, the 72-story hotel is intersected by a sloping plane in section which increases the area of the lower floors. Rectilinear in plan, the 63-story hotel extends its parallel walls to a curved plan form developing an atrium at the top of the building.
