



## **MARRIOT HOTEL- SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA**

**CLIENT:** Marriot Corporation

**COMPLETION:** 1989

**DESCRIPTION:** The first building constructed in the 24-acre Yerba Buena Gardens redevelopment project this 38-story luxury hotel has over 1,500 rooms. The hotel is situated in a prime location of downtown San Francisco. The project includes an underground structure connected to the hotel via a tunnel beneath Mission Street, which contains a ballroom plus meeting spaces and a banquet kitchen. An exhibit area and additional meeting rooms are located at the hotel basement level with additional conference suites at the third and fourth floors. There are two restaurants, a lobby bar, and a cocktail lounge on the second floor. There is a health club and swimming pool on the third and fourth floors and a sky-lounge located on the top floor. Three basement levels contain parking, loading, and employee facilities which were designed to connect to a larger underground parking facility.

**COST:** \$120 million Project was built on time and under budget.
