



EDWARD R. ROYBAL COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH CENTER- EAST LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA

DESCRIPTION: *The Roybal Comprehensive Health Center was commissioned in 1975 as a primary care medical facility enclosing two levels of medical services and two levels of parking within a simple rectangular volume. In planning the center, Anthony J. Lumsden intended to create a building that the East Los Angeles community would identify with. The rich colors and figures of the Ruming Codex animate the primary geometric forms, a radical departure from conventional institutional buildings. Evoking the exuberance of Mexican art, the glazed ceramic tile facades are wrapped in angular, intensely colored geometric ribbons.*

COST: \$4 million
