



SUWON JANGAN GU GOVERNMENT COMPLEX - SUWON, KOREA

DESCRIPTION: Competition design for 15-story government complex. This is a building which allows easy access and use and a sense of order, dignity and scale appropriate for a public building. The building is designed so that spaces which require the most public access are at grade. Official spaces with limited or undesirable public access are on the upper levels. The various departments including Multipurpose Citizen Hall, Water Department and Health Clinic are all attached to the public linear space with easily controlled public access to any of these components. From the exterior, this main linear spine serves as a visual ordering device to which the varied massing of the individual building components are attached.
