



**WORLDWAY POSTAL CENTER- LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA**

**CLIENT:** United States Postal Office  
**COMPLETION:** 1971

**DESCRIPTION:** Located at the south end of Century Boulevard between Airport and Sky Chief Boulevard in the Cargo City Development area of the Los Angeles International Airport, this two-story building with basement has a total area of 380,731 square feet. The interior accommodates the fully automated mail processing system. Adjacent to the main building is a spiral ramp providing access to roof parking with room for 480 cars. Reinforced concrete was used throughout the building with 32- by 36 foot bays with flat slab construction, concrete supporting columns with belled caps. This facility contains provisions for interfacing with air cargo train carts as well as conveyor systems with chutes, sorting, and distribution equipment for mail pouches.

**COST:** \$12 million  
**ROLE:** As former Corporate Director of Design for DMJM, Anthony Lumsden was the Design Architect of this project.  
**STATUS:** Project is built.
