



CHANGI MERIDIEN HOTEL - CHANGI VILLAGE, SINGAPORE

COMPLETION: 1985

DESCRIPTION: This six-story 400,000 square-foot hotel complex on a triangular site is located within one mile of Changi International Airport. The plan focuses on creating a quality hotel that can meet the needs of an ever growing number of tourists, particularly business travelers. The hotel is surrounded by a golf course and looks across a broad estuary towards Malaysia. The five levels above the ground floor house the hotel's 293 guest rooms. A single loaded corridor system serves the guest rooms and opens onto a heavily planted garden atrium. Internally, a multilevel atrium houses restaurants, lounges and an elevated swimming pool. The plan combines a triangular organization for the typical rooms following the site configuration with curvilinear forms for the special suites and atrium spaces and functions.

COST: \$30 million
ROLE: As former Corporate Director of Design for DMJM, Anthony Lumsden was the Design Architect of this project.
STATUS: Project is built.
