



HERTZ TURNAROUND FACILITY- LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA

CLIENT: Hertz Corporation
COMPLETION: 1971

DESCRIPTION: *The Hertz Corporation's Turnaround Facility at Los Angeles International Airport includes automobile rentals, customer return, car washing and fueling, administrative and customer services. The rental/return building is a two-story 16,000 square foot structure. The first floor is assigned to customer service and rental return and the second floor is assigned to administration and lot surveillance. On each side of the site are 60 foot by 340 foot wash/fuel bays, each with eight fuel islands and two car wash bays. At each quadrant of the site are express kiosks and canopy shelters for customer waiting. At the southwest corner of the site is the main dispatch building, which houses all keys and rental contracts. All buildings are connected by an underground pneumatic tube system.*

COST: \$ 19 million
