DESCRIPTION: *The Kelantan kite, an artistic symbol of Malaysia as well as a symbol of flight, receives a new expression as the design direction for the greatly expanded Kota Bharu International Airport. The new facilities include an 11,000-foot runway and parallel taxiway with Category II instrument landing system, a new passenger terminal building with four loading bridges, an initial parking apron for eight wide-body aircraft, cargo and support buildings and facilities with appropriate parking and infrastructure.*
