



LAS VEGAS CITY HALL COMPLEX- LAS VEGAS, NEVADA

DESCRIPTION: *This 11-story travertine triangular tower provides office space for various city departments including; city administrative functions, police and fire departments and municipal courts and parking for 200. Vehicle and pedestrian circulation in and around the multipurpose, 270,000 square foot civic center was a complex design problem that was solved with a simple-to-use series of multilevel throughway and ramps. The low-rise portion of the complex houses police department, municipal courts, city council chambers, and communications center. A circular, glass enclosed, three-level pedestrian walkway connects the tower with the other buildings.*

COST: \$10 million
ROLE: Anthony Lumsden was the Design Architect.
STATUS: Project is built.
