THE 150,000 SQ. FT. MASTERPLAN INCLUDES 2500-PERSON CONGREGATION SANCTUARY, 1000 PERSON CONGREGATION SANCTUARY, GYMNASIUM, EDUCATIONAL BUILDING, ADMINISTRATION OFFICES, DINING HALL, OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATER AND A FELLOWSHIP HALL. THE MAIN EDUCATIONAL BUILDING AND THE 1000-PERSON CONGREGATION SANCTUARY WILL BE THE FOCUS OF THE 53,000 SQ. FT. PHASE I DEVELOPMENT. THE PHASE I DEVELOPMENT INCLUDES THE 1000-PERSON SANCTUARY, DINING HALL FOR 500, CHAPEL, ENTRY ROTUNDA, AND A CENTRAL COURTYARD. THE EDUCATIONAL BUILDING HOUSES CLASSROOMS, OFFICES, CHAPELS, A NURSERY SCHOOL, AND A MAIN LIBRARY.

THE BUILDINGS ARE GROUPED AROUND A LARGE CIRCULAR PARKING LOT WITH THE MAIN PEDESTRIAN AXIS ORGANIZING THE MAIN SANCTUARY AND AMPHITHEATER. EDUCATIONAL BUILDING WINGS ARE PLACED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE MAIN

SANCTUARY FORMING AN INTERIOR COURTYARD WITH RELATIONSHIP TO THE GYMNASIUM AND FELLOWSHIP HALL. BUILDINGS ARE CONNECTED BY A COVERED ARCADE WHICH ALSO DEFINES THE OPEN SPACES. THE COMPLEX ALLOWS THE CHURCH MEMBERS TO ENTER THE COMPLEX THROUGH VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND ENCOURAGES USAGE OF OUTDOOR SPACES FOR SOCIALIZING, PERFORMANCES AND SPORTING ACTIVITIES. THE DESIGN IS INTENDED TO ELEVATE THE FEELING OF SPIRITUALITY BY CREATING A VARIETY OF SPATIAL ATMOSPHERES THROUGH THE USE OF LIGHT.
