DESCRIPTION: This 65,000 sf building provides space for a 100,000 volume library collection, individual study spaces, a television studio, photographic laboratories, a graphic design studio, print shop, and audiovisual rooms. The north side of the building integrates a landscaped area with fountains, sculpture garden, and a private reading court. The building's interior is comprised of five interconnecting levels unified by a three story open space. Rich upholstery and oak furniture bring warmth and character to the interior.
